Every Spring season in Minnesota a dramatic transformation takes place. The transformation of spring is a joy to behold, one leaf, one flower, one blade of grass at a time.



Did you hear? The blood and bone of the savior walks and lives and talks again and even eats a fish dinner on the shore of the Sea of Galilee! What???

A shocking Renaissance era painting depicts Thomas literally putting his finger inside of Jesus' wound. It is a reminder of the grit and gristle of the torturous cross and the unbelievable physical and sensory realities of the resurrection.

Ephesians 1:13 says "you who heard the message of the truth, the Good News offering you deliverance, and put your trust in the Messiah (Christ) were sealed by him with the promised Ruach HaKodesh (Holy Spirit)" (CJB)



I wonder how many times I've simply moved on from the wonder of Easter back to my ordinary life? I wonder how many times I have misunderstood the role of the Holy Spirit, hoping for a magical zap to suddenly wake me up out of my unbelief?

That's not how this works. This scripture clearly states.. "YOU who heard the message of the truth and believed... and were sealed... with the Holy Spirit." (Eph. 1:13)

So, I have to ask... Have you heard? Have you seen? Have you touched? Have you believed?

Have *YOU* experienced the dramatic transformation to life knowing that Jesus lives?

We are so excited to welcome our children back to Elim Kids! Now that we've had a few Sundays under our belt, we have come up with check-in and pick-up procedure going forward.

Please make sure your kids are checked in before Sunday Service starts at 10 am. Use the Church Center app (visit churchcenter.com on your mobile device to download the app) to pre-register or using our in-person check-in system on the 2nd Floor, before the service starts.

We require one parent/guardian to physically come to the 3rd Floor Lobby to confirm the registration (before or during the service, even if using the app), so if you cannot register before the service, you will need to accompany your child to do so, when they are released in the service.



Helping Our Neighbor: Sacred Heart of Jesus Parish

When I heard that a church in NE Minneapolis had caught fire on Monday evening just 24 hours before the verdict of Derek Chauvin was to be announced my heart sank. As if Minneapolis needed one more thing to worry about! Sacred Heart of Jesus Parish, located at 5th and 22nd Ave. in NE Minneapolis is a National Polish Catholic Church and has stood for more than 100 years.

I drove by the day after the fire to survey the damage and a crew of neighbors and some church members were there, hauling valuable items out of the church across the street to the fellowship hall. Being moved by the whole scene, I introduced myself to Father John, who has been the parish leader since 1993, and told him I'd be back the next day.



So Davon (one of our Elim Youth off of school for the day) and I went that Wednesday morning. We hauled boards, stripped nails from deconstructed pew benches, and loaded some large items out of the church and into the dumpster. The feeling of heaviness and grief was definitely in the air alongside the smell of ash and cinders.

We took a lunch break and they generously invited us to eat with them. It was a special time of reflection and thinking about what had just happened. We were blessed to have met some new friends, who already felt like old friends. Please pray for Father John Kutek and his wife Renata as they deal with these tragic circumstances. John and Renata have been leading church since 1993 and their daughter attended Elim Preschool. Pray for the congregation as they rebuild and cope with the loss.

After a much-needed break, we all returned refreshed and energized and ready to finish the school year. The children have been a joy and comfort during these trying times, and I am so happy that we were able to make another school year happen.

I taught a class this year of Minneapolis children who were not yet in school due to distance learning. The kids were from grades Kindergarten-2nd grade and they were a delight. Seeing their faces daily is truly what kept me moving forward, and having 35 of them helped us survive. (Our numbers were very low when we started in the Fall, but doing this kept us moving forward and made it possible for all the teachers to continue to work.) While most went back

when the schools opened last month, I continued with a daily class. It is what motivates me and reminds me of all the good in the world.

I am so thankful for this staff. They have also stepped up and done what needs to be done to help the preschool continue the mission it was intended to so many years ago. Elim is blessed.

We are moving into our summer session starting in June, and have more kids registered than during the school year! A fantastic feeling. We are open for registration for the School Year 2021-2022. Pass the word.
