"Life Under the Sun: Part 9 - The Test of Wisdom and Truth"

Last Week: Happiness is not something to be pursued, it is a by-product of a life lived in God. Like money and possessions, happiness is fleeting (like vapor) but it is God's gift, so be 'occupied with joy' all the days of your life.

This Week: In the somewhat cryptic sixth chapter of Ecclesiastes we are left with more questions than answers. Yet, even in the questions, we can find answers. What advantage is there to living wisely? How can we tell if someone is wise or lives out the truth? Why can't we know what the future holds?

We look at Scripture and the life of Jesus to learn what wisdom and truth are.
