SERMON NOTES

"Life Under the Sun: Part 10 - Better is the End of a Thing..."

Pastor Paul Stephen Olson

We continue in our series from the book of Ecclesiastes. In the central chapters of this book the author offers practical life for wise living in the realm of temporality and vanity "under the sun". The opposite of the foolish and evil life is to choose a life of "tov" - the better/good life. Choosing 'tov' encompasses all of life including our attitudes, thoughts, feelings, and outlook. Living a tov life impacts our decisions about money, relationships, marriage, work, joy, and even death.

Today's Scripture: Ecc. 7:1-12, summary statement - verse 8:

"Better is the end of a thing than its beginning..."

Charles Spurgeon (1834-1892): "And, Christians, as you think of the losses, crosses, sufferings, and bereavements which you have had during this year, can you feel any regrets that it is gone? Must not each one of you say, "I thank God that stormy voyage is over and I have not those tempests to endure"? (Sermon on Christmas Day, 1864)
