SERMON NOTES

"Life Under the Sun: Part 11 - Take Hold of Righteousness... and Wickedness" Pastor Paul Stephen Olson

"The sages of Israel teach that those who would be wise aim not at power but at goodness (tov). Power and goodness are not close buddies." - OT Scholar, Ellen Davis

We continue in our series from the book of Ecclesiastes. In this book's central chapters, the author offers practical life for wise living in the realm of temporality and vanity "under the sun". The opposite of the foolish and evil life is to choose a life of "tov" - the better/good life. Choosing 'tov' encompasses all of life including our attitudes, thoughts, feelings, and outlook. Living a toy life impacts our decisions about money, relationships, marriage, work, joy, and even death.

Today's Scripture Passage: Ecc 7:13-29, Key Verse 7:18
Life Lesson #23:
Ecclesiastes/Qohelet 7:18 So don't overdo goodness and don't act the wise man to excess, or you may be dumbfounded. Don't overdo wickedness and don't be a fool, or you may die before your time. It is best (tov) that you grasp the one without letting go of the other, for one who fears God will do his duty by both. (JPS Translation, 1985)
