"Life Under the Sun: Part 15 - Celebrating God's Favor"

Dr. James D. Smith III (Elim '73-'76, '85-'91)

Last Week: Chapter 9:13-18 A heroic tale of a poor man's wisdom that saves an entire city, yet he was not remembered. Qohelet concludes: "Wisdom is better than weapons of war, but one bungler destroys much good."

Today's Scripture Passage: Ecclesiastes 9:7-10

The Firm Foundation: God's "Yes" (v.7)

Stewardship of life's stew – faithful to God's Word & Spirit. Gladness & joy in daily blessings. Quote: "Well done, good & faithful servant... enter into the Lord's joy." Matt. 25:23 IJLC

The Hour of Decision: My "Yes" (v.8)

We have a choice. Habits shape habitat. White garments (purity), anointed life (purpose). Quotes: "Before you are life & death, blessings & curses...so choose life! (Deut. 30:19) DWP "Carpe diem = pluck the moment" Eccl. 2:24-26, 3:12-13, 5:8-20, 8:15, 9:7-10, 11:9-12:1

The Shared Celebration: Our "Yes" (v.9)

Enjoy life, woven together in love: husbands & wives, fellow-laborers, unbroken (Eccl. 4:9-12) Quote: "L'Chaim" (Heb) literally "To Lives!" (Ours & beloved neighbors, time & eternity) FOR

The Loving Vocation: Forever "Yes" (v.10)

What's chosen wisely, do whole-heartedly! Animated by your *koach*: ability, strength, vigor." Quote: "God's promises are "Yes" in Christ; thru him Amen – to God's glory!" (2Cor.1:20) COF
