SERMON NOTES

"Where Are We? Who Are We? and, What Are We Doing?" Part 1 Pastor Paul Stephen Olson

Today's Scripture: 1 Peter 5:10-14 (we will focus on verses 13 and 14)

1 Peter addresses the real issues faced by the people on a day to day basis such as slander, misunderstanding from neighbors, divided households, tensions at work, and conflicts with civil authorities, and encourages them (with comforting words) to "do good" in every circumstance as a reflection of the "true grace of God".

"slander and hostility": chs. 2:18, 20-23; 3:9, 14-16 "doing good": chs. 2:12, 15, 20;3:16; 4:19

Where are we?

Intro to Peter's first letter

1 Peter 1:1 To God's elect, exiles scattered throughout the provinces of Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia and Bithynia, 2 who have been chosen according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through the sanctifying work of the Spirit, to be obedient to Jesus Christ and sprinkled with his blood: Grace and peace be yours in abundance.

Ending of Peter's first letter

1 Peter 5:13-14 "She who is in Babylon, chosen together with you, sends you her greetings, and so does my son Mark." Greet one another with a kiss of love. Peace to all of you who are in Christ.

"Babylon" - a code for exile/diaspora. ('Babylon' did not exist)

"Chosen/Elect" - New Covenant family of God, sprinkled in the blood of Christ

"Greetings" - a warm greeting heard when entering someone's home.

"Kiss of Love" - a cultural practice used during early Christian gatherings

"Grace and Peace" - an early Christian greeting and salutation
