In these discussions, we will look at the Bible, remember our history, and discuss how Christians work towards racial justice and reconciliation today. Questions we will discuss are: How do Christians reconcile with our past? How has historic racism shaped our city today? And whose voices are you listening to? We will use video segments from Christian leaders like Jemar Tisby and Nicole Martin; learn about racial covenants in Hennepin Country from the Mapping Prejudice Project; and discuss how the prophets Daniel, Ezra, and Nehemiah, the first New Testament Deacons, and the Apostle Peter guide the way Christians respond.

In this sermon series, we will take 5 weeks to examine the Lord's Prayer.

Last 2 weeks: "Heavenly Petitions"

Pray then in this way:

V9 "Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name". (petition #1)
V10 "Your kingdom come." (petition #2)
"Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven" (petition #3)

This week, Matt 6:11-12: "Terrestrial Petitions"

11 Give us this day our daily bread.

(petition #4)

"We are called to change the politics of hunger" - Rev. David Beckman (former president of Bread for the World, 1991-2020)

What is "Daily Bread"? (3 things)

- Nutrition and Sustenance (physical health)
- Protection and Payment (leading to peace and prosperity)
- Jesus, "I am your bread" John 6:35

12 And forgive us our debts,

(petition #5)

This is not: "There were mistakes"

"Debt" is serious and deadly - Matthew the Tax Collector

as we also have forgiven our debtors.


Comparing Luke's Prayer, Lk. 11:4

- 2. When you pray about 'daily bread' what comes to mind? How might that look the same as others? What looks different for you?
- 3. Who are your debtors and how do you forgive them?
