Race, Racism and the Church

In the Dining Room at 11:15 am

In these discussions, we will look at the Bible, remember our history, and discuss how Christians work towards racial justice and reconciliation today. Questions we will discuss are: How do Christians reconcile with our past? How has historic racism shaped our city today? And whose voices are you listening to? We will use video segments from Christian leaders like Jemar Tisby and Nicole Martin; learn about racial covenants in Hennepin County from the Mapping Prejudice Project; and discuss how the prophets Daniel, Ezra, and Nehemiah, the first New Testament Deacons, and the Apostle Peter guide the way Christians respond.

October 10: In today's Sunday Connections series, the key question we will discuss is--How has historic racism shaped our city today? We will read how the first Deacons in Acts 6 responded to disparities, and learn about racial covenants in Hennepin County and other disparities.

“Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.” (petition #3)

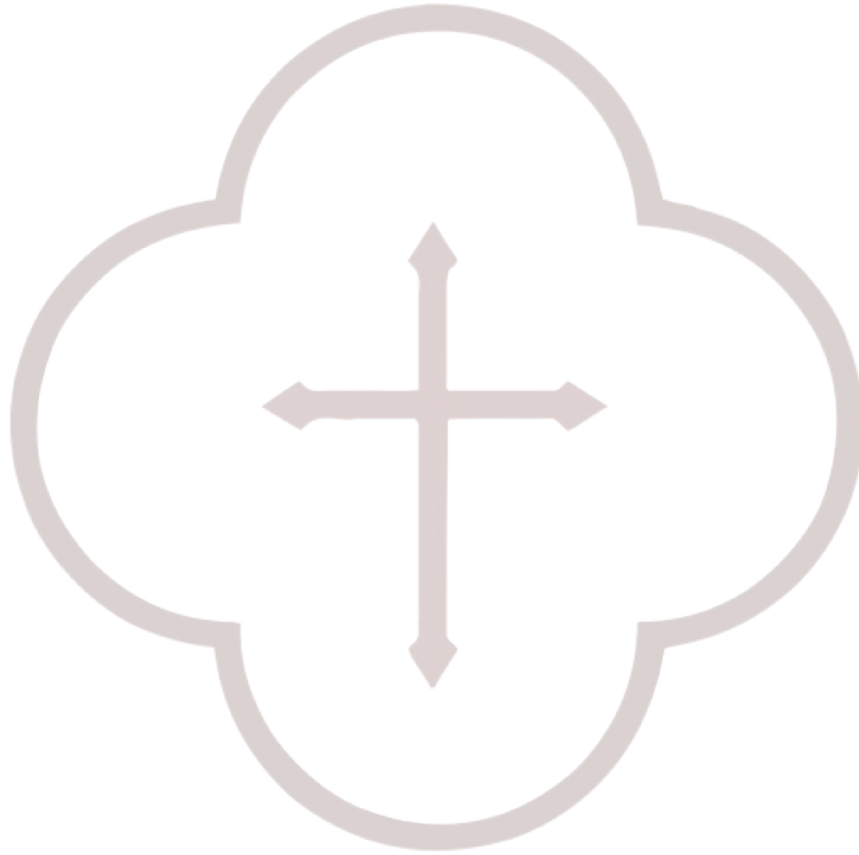
Terrestrial Petitions

V11 “Give us this day our daily bread.” (petition #4)

V12 “And forgive us our debts,
As we also have forgiven our debtors.” (petition #5)*This week, Matt 6:13****13 And lead us not into temptation** (time of test/trial) (petition #6)**But deliver us from the evil one.** (petition #7)***...*for yours is the kingdom, the power, and glory forever. Amen.*** (added in later manuscripts)**Discussion/Reflection Questions:**

1. Jesus instructs his disciples to be aware in the midst of times of testing. (Luke 22:31-32, Mark 14:32-42. How do these stories relate to the Lord's prayer? (petition #6)
2. Why do we need to daily pray for deliverance? And... deliverance from what/whom?
3. How does prayer help us experience God's kingdom, power, and glory in our lives?
