Today's Scripture Text: Mary's Song in Luke 1:46-55

The Names of God in the Christmas Story Reveal the Promises of Christmas El Elyon - God Most High "He will be called 'Son of the Most High God'" Jehovah Tsidkenu - God Our Righteousness 'He is the righteous branch of Jesse' Jehovah Jireh - God Our Provider 'you will give birth to a Son, he will be Holy' Jehovah Shammah - God is Present - "He is Emmanuel God with us" El Shaddai - The Almighty God - "The Mighty God has done great things for me" Jehovah Shalom - The God who is Peace - 'He is the prince of peace'

Mary is overwhelmed by the promise and power of God to save her people. Luke 1:46-49

She exclaims, "My soul magnifies the Lord, and my spirit rejoices in God my Savior, for he has looked with favor on the lowliness of his servant... for the Mighty One has done great things for me and holy is his name."

Mary foresees that this savior would... Luke 1:50-53

"Vanquish evil, Bring down the prideful, Defeat the powerful, And lift up the lowly, and fill them with good things."

Who is **El Shaddai**?


El - (masc. noun) a mighty or powerful title. "Elohim" plural EL, for mighty rulers judges, divine beings, angels, or gods. El often connotes authority and refers to the one true God of Israel.

Shaddai - (masc. noun) but refers to the female breast. Plural: 'many breasted' Early Use: Fertility blessings Genesis 28:3, 35:11 and 49:25

Later Use: from 'shad': → 'mountain' (shad) powerful and high.

El Shaddai is the God of hope for the enslaved, widowed, powerless, unrecognized, the sinner, the suffering, the oppressed, and the downtrodden. Is El Shaddai your God too?
