

Our goal: "...finding God in all things in order that we might love and serve God in all" - Ignatius of Loyola

What is Spiritual transformation?

The process of the examined life: "A leader is a person who must take special responsibility for what's going on inside of him/herself, inside his or her consciousness." - Parker Palmer

The role of **seeking**, **Scripture**, and **sacrifice** in the process of transformation.

Seeking God in Transformation: finding and being found

"Search me and know me." - King David, Psalm 139

"Ask and it will be given to you..." - Jesus, Matt 7:7

Scriptures for Transformation: finding and being in truth

"...for this sums up the Law and the Prophets." - The Golden Rule, Jesus in Matt 7:12 Mindfulness vs. Meditation or Contemplative Thought

Sacrifice and Transformation: finding holiness and being holy

"Enter through the narrow gate..." - Matt 7:13

"Offer your body as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God." - Rom. 12:1-2

Closing Prayer (from the book Pursuing God's Will Together, pgs. 48-49)
O God, let something happen to me, something more than interesting or entertaining or thoughtful.

O God, let something essential happen to me, something awesome, something real. Speak to my condition, Lord, and change me somewhere inside where it matters,
