## “A Glimpse of Glory” - Palm Sunday

The story of the triumphal entry is one of the few incidents in the life of Jesus which appears in all four Gospel accounts (Matthew 21:1-17; Mark 11:1-11; Luke 19:29-40; John 12:12-19) Palm Sunday commemorates the waving of palms branches at Jesus' entry into Jerusalem during Passover and marks the beginning of Easter Holy Week.

- In the beginning, God created the neighborhood
  
- Neighborly Questions (Job 10:3, Gen 18:25, Psalm 13:1-2)
  
- A Kingly Entry: It's like Christmas all over again!
  
- Jesus borrows from the neighborhood
  
- A Glimpse of Glory

- Radical Hospitality: Can we make our own sacred spaces ready for others?
