"Come and See" (Introduction to Experiencing God)



Text: John 1:35-42 (An experiencing God movement is formed)

The gospel of Jesus Christ, (Word made flesh, John 1:14) means that it's not enough to just 'know about' God but that we can do God's will and experience his presence in our lives.

Experiencing God in our lives begins as a self-replicating process of discovery, encounter and invitation.

- 1. Discovery John 1:35-38a
 - a. Someone points the way (John the Baptist and the Holy Spirit)
 - b. We see for ourselves (they saw and followed him)
 - c. Our motives are exposed (What do you want? Jesus asked)
- 2. Encounter John 1:38a-40
 - a. Further Inquiry (where are you staying?)
 - b. They followed further ("come and see" Jesus said)
 - c. They spent time together (until the tenth hour)
- 3. Invitation John 1:41-42
 - a. Not personal but communal (he found his brother)
 - b. We bring others into discovery and encounter (he brought him to Jesus)
 - c. New name and identity (you shall be called Cephas)
- We don't discover God at work in the world because...
- We don't encounter Jesus because...
- We don't invite others because...
- We stop experiencing God in our lives because...



Hope Avenue Twin Cities is open as a day shelter at 1229 Logan Avenue North as the Fire Inspector ordered building improvements before men can continue to sleep there. As such, it's been a while since we've given an update.

- HATC received its 501(c)(3) during Holy Week and is now an independent nonprofit ministry.
- Junail Freeman Anderson and Freedom from the Streets now operate alongside us there.
- We have applied for City Council approval for a zoning variance to host a 24/7 men's shelter there.
- And we await word on a large grant with Hennepin County that we've applied for. This would allow us to finish building improvements, and hire additional staff. The grant would not be applied to our programming which is Christ-based.

Please pray for us as we follow the Lord and love His people. Our desire is to help our Guests grow in their relationship with Christ and away from the addictions and idols of the world that distract them from becoming who God has called them to be.
