"He Sat Down"

New Series! Join us this fall for a new series on the section of Matthew known as 'The Sermon on the Mount'. We will explore the dynamic and explosive teachings of Jesus and ask ourselves how we might live in greater obedience and with greater purpose in our daily lives.

Text: Matthew 4:23-5:1

The Good News of Jesus. What is it?

Matt. 4:23 Jesus went throughout Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, proclaiming the good news of the kingdom, and healing every disease and sickness among the people.

- Reading the Gospels: "The worlds behind, in front of, and in the text."
- "Good news" of old. The prophet Isaiah tells us 100s of years earlier. (Isaiah 25:6-8)
- "Jesus was attempting to "renew local community in villages and towns, to strengthen and renew family and community relations and reverse the downward spiral of violence" (Jonathan Draper, Local Community in Galilee Article)

The renown of Jesus. Who is this man becoming and why should we trust him?

24 News about him spread all over Syria, and people brought to him all who were ill with various diseases, those suffering severe pain, the demon-possessed, those having seizures, and the paralyzed; and he healed them. 25 Large crowds from Galilee, the Decapolis, Jerusalem, Judea and the region across the Jordan followed him.

 "In the ancient world, religion, politics, and economics were inextricably bound together. For Israelites, fidelity to God's covenant encompassed every dimension of life... In contrast to the Pharisees, who stressed purity and boundaries, Jesus' teaching was more oriented to economic and social relations, and focused specifically on issues of poverty and debt." (Fortress Commentary)

Jesus sat down. Why does it matter? (What does the SOTM do for us?)

Matt. 5:1 Now when Jesus saw the crowds, he went up on a mountainside and sat down. His disciples came to him, 2 and he began to teach them.

- To subdue enemies. Psalm 110:1 (most often quoted verse in NT)
- To communicate on our level. Luke 22:14 (Jesus reclined at the table)
- To secure our future. Eph. 1:20-23 (he reigns, seated forever)
