Text: Matthew 5:1-9 (Focusing on Beatitudes 1-3)

As our church discerns a major decision, and desiring to seek God's will first in all things, we revisit the 'blessings' Jesus pronounced over his disciples. (Comfort, Instruction, Direction)

Makarios - Blessing (Why does Jesus begin by pronouncing 'blessings'?) Psalm 1:1 (Blessed is the one), 119:1-2 (Hebrew letter Aleph - Asher, "Blessed")

#1 Matt. 5:3 "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven."

- NLT "Blessed are those who recognize their need for God"
- "It is first and finally Jesus who defines what it means to be 'poor in spirit.' It is he himself who discloses and embodies not simply poverty but extreme poverty." (G. Hunsinger "The Beatitudes", p. 5)

#2 Matt. 5:4 "Blessed are those who mourn, for they will be comforted."

- Jesus wept over his friend Lazarus, and the temple/city. (John 12, Luke 19)
- We walk in a world of monuments. Mourn the past and present, looking to the future.

#3 Matt. 5:5 "Blessed are the meek (gentle, mild), for they will inherit the earth."

- "Meekness is both a spiritual aptitude and social condition." Hunsigner, p. 31
- Jesus in Matt 11:29 We are being shaped as "living stones" by the master.
- "Neither novelty nor nostalgia make good masters" Pastor Jim Smith


Fall Refreshment at Trout Lake for Women (Sept 23-25, 2022)
