SERMON NOTES

"You are Salt and Light, You!" (SOTM, Part 5)

Pastor Paul Stephen Olson

Text: Matt 5:13-16

In studying the Sermon on the Mount, special attention has been given to the "world behind, the world of, and the world in front of" the text. Jesus offers us a new embodied identity as his children, while highlighting the precarious and dangerous alternatives of living life in darkness and without purpose.

13 "You are the salt of the earth.

 Ancient uses of salt included practical benefits of preservation of food, making a covenantal pledge, Babylonian, Persian, Arabic and Greek treaties, a sacrifice of testimony/worship (Lev. 2:13), an agent of purification (2 Kings 2:19-23, Exodus 30:35)

But if the salt loses its saltiness (becomes tasteless), how can it be made salty again? It is no longer good for anything, except to be thrown out and trampled underfoot.

- Salt can become so mixed with impurities as to become useless (Pliny the Elder)
- **Greek:** Tasteless, also means 'foolish'. Because of Jesus' teachings, most early Christians resisted foolish behavior that lead to death and destruction. (Destruction of the Temple, 66CE, 6000+ Jews Died, and Bar Kochba 115-117 ("a false messiah", Talmud) more than 580,000 Jews died in the rebellion)
- Exile theology versus Landed Theology (How do we live in a post-christian society?)

14 "You are the light of the world. A town built on a hill cannot be hidden.

- "Let there be light" (Gen 1:3) God is not 'a' light, God is the author and creator of light.
- The "New Jerusalem" will shed its light throughout all the world (G. von Rad)
- Rab Kahana, 'Jerusalem is destined to be a beacon for the nations of the earth, and they will walk in its light'

15 Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead they put it on its stand, and it gives light to everyone in the house.

- The saints are the locus of God's activity in the world (WD Davies)
- "the followers of Jesus are to be windows through which the divine light enters the world." St. John of the Cross

16 In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven.

- Jesus calls us the salt of the earth to live with integrity, authenticity, longevity, sincerity, and preserving agent for the world.
- "Integrity means you're the same in private as you are in public. Be real. Be authentic. Our world expects no less. Our people deserve no less. Our Lord requires no less...You are the light of the world, You are the salt of the earth. What you are may impact the world for Christ more than anything you ever say or do." (The Pastor's Handbook)
