SERMON NOTES

"Kingdom and Covenant Trust" (SOTM Part 8)

Pastor Paul Stephen Olson

Text: Matthew 5:27-37

Last week: The "sign" of the law is fulfilled in Jesus who gives us a better command. Exceeding the righteousness of the Pharisees means drilling down into the internal matters of the heart! Sin begets more sin, so we do everything we can to eliminate it in our lives!

Jesus teaches on kingdom and covenant loyalty: "As such, the **Sermon on the Mount** provides a vision of how discipleship ought to look as God comes to make all things right."

After the Beatitudes, Rabbi Jesus intensifies six particular commands of Torah:

1. Murder (Last week) Jesus warns against protracted anger that leads to insults or worse!. Jesus encourages making amends with others we have wronged asap!

2. Adultery - V.28 (NLT) "But I say, anyone who even looks at a woman with lust has already committed adultery with her in his heart."

3. Divorce - V.32 (NLT) "But I say that a man who divorces his wife, unless she has been unfaithful, causes her to commit adultery."

4. Breaking Vows - V.37 (NLT): "All you need to say is simply 'Yes' or 'No'; anything beyond this comes from the evil one."

"Put a fence around it" Practical Application: Breaking one of these commands constitutes a serious violation of kingdom and covenant loyalty. As was typical of 1st-century Rabbis, Jesus teaches his disciples to 'put a fence' around the law (sin like a pit, if fallen into, results in serious human injury).


