Hope Avenue Twin Cities: I am highlighting our specific financial needs per donor requests:

- We are blessed with receiving a \$25,000 anonymous donation when we raise that much in December as matching dollars for ongoing operational and programming work, and addiction recovery work.
- The City of Minneapolis has notified us that we must pay an additional permitting fee of \$7,000 to open an overnight shelter. This includes the SAC charges.
- Our annual insurance premium is \$6,500 with 25% due as a downpayment. This includes Package, Liability, Automobile, and Umbrella policies. The Directors and Officers policy is due also, \$1050.
- We are raising \$5,000 to fund our Heavenly Burrito Van work.

The costs are great but we trust in our God who called us to do this work for His people. Because we do not receive federal or county funds to support the shelter, we look to God's people to partner with us. But most of all, we covet your prayer.

Text: Matthew 7:1-6 and Third Sunday of Advent: Candle of Joy

Advent Verses: Isaiah 35:1-10, John 3:16-19, Luke 2:1-7

This week: Jesus addresses universal blindness, the Christ child arrives incognito, and the joy of life with others is key to experiencing the coming of Christ in its fullest!

1 "Do not judge, or you too will be judged. 2 For in the same way you judge others, you will be judged, and with the measure you use, it will be measured to you.

3 "Why do you look at the speck of sawdust in your brother's eye and pay no attention to the plank in your own eye? 4 How can you say to your brother, 'Let me take the speck out of your eye,' when all the time there is a plank in your own eye? 5 You hypocrite, first take the plank out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to remove the speck from your brother's eye.

6 "Do not give dogs what is sacred; do not throw your pearls to pigs. If you do, they may trample them under their feet, and turn and tear you to pieces.
